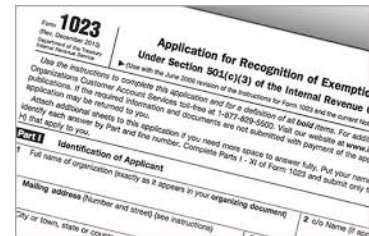
Nonprofit Status

Our 501(c)3 application has been submitted to the IRS! It was a long and arduous process, meeting all the criteria to file for the application, but we learned a lot and got it done! Our CPA told us it usually takes 2-3 months for the IRS to review the application. Please pray that we get approval quickly.

According to the IRS website:

*If the application is approved, **charitable contributions to it will be deductible back to the date of formation.***

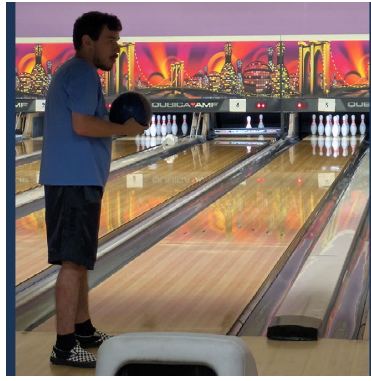
